For nearly two decades, Rood-Clifford has been dedicated to making positive change through advancing nonprofit missions in her professional career. As Starlight's Vice President of Philanthropy, she grew Starlight's philanthropic revenue by more than 50% while increasing its fundraising capacity and launched its first major multi-million-dollar fundraising campaign in almost 20 years. Rood-Clifford established new initiatives to build and steward Starlight's donor base and key civic and public stakeholder relationships. Previously, Rood-Clifford served in senior roles for Starlight's for-profit subsidiary EPIC Innovative Events, serving as a consultant for nonprofit and corporate clients in Kansas City and across the country, using theatre and storytelling as the foundation to advance brands and missions.

Rood-Clifford stated, "It is a great honor to be appointed President + C.E.O. of Starlight. I have been privileged to call Starlight my home for more than 16 years, and this organization has meant so much to me throughout my life and career. As a high schooler, I participated in the Blue Star Awards program at Starlight, and I'm so proud to be leading the organization that inspired me to pursue a career in the arts sector. Starlight is poised for tremendous growth. As we move forward into the future, I am dedicated to connecting our entire community through live arts experiences for ALL generations." Rood-Clifford continued, "It is my desire and commitment to serve the Kansas City community with the utmost of excellence in all that Starlight can offer through the best Broadway musicals, concerts, community engagement programs, and events. I couldn't be more excited for this next chapter of Starlight's story."

A lifelong Kansas City native, Rood-Clifford's first theatre memories are of attending Starlight performances with her family and friends. She is also a product of several Starlight community engagement programs, having participated in the Blue Star Awards program and beginning her arts administration career as a summer intern in the Bob Rohlf Internships Program.

Outside of Starlight, Lindsey is the President of the Kansas City Chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals; the Secretary of the Kansas City Chamber of Commerce's Centurions Alumni Board; past chair of Kansas City's National Philanthropy Day; and a Vice President on the Board of Directors for In the Name of GRACE, a foundation dedicated to serving those recovering from addiction. She is a 2017 graduate of the Greater Kansas City Chamber of Commerce's Centurions Leadership Program. Rood-Clifford received a B.A. in English from the University of Kansas.
