- Legally Blonde The Musical aired in its entirety during an MTV Special in 2008, making it the first Broadway show to appear on TV while still being performed on Broadway.
- After the popularity of the MTV special, the reality television series "Legally Blonde The Musical:
   The Search for Elle Woods" was created, which showed viewers the audition process for casting
   the next Elle Woods on Broadway.
- The winner, Bailey Hanks, played Elle Woods on Broadway from July 2008 until the show closed in October of 2008. The runner-up to Hanks on the TV series, Autumn Hurlbert, served as her understudy.
- Kate Shindle, who originated the role of Vivienne Kensington on Broadway, was Miss America 1998 and is the current President of the Actor's Equity Association.
- Legally Blonde The Musical was nominated for seven Tony Awards including Best Original Score and Best Book of a Musical.
